

This park is home to wild birds and beautiful flora, including sawtooth oaks and Japanese oaks. In this precious natural environment you can bask in the beauty of nature and appreciate the changing face of the forest throughout the year, from cherry blossoms in spring to the turning leaves in fall. The park is dotted with cultural facilities such as the Taro Okamoto Museum of Art, the Japan Open-air Folk House Museum and the Kawasaki Municipal Science Museum. 
シェアサイクル Leisurely Sightseeing with Shared Bicycles HELLO CYCLING

It is the only registered natural science museum in the city that offers exhibits, observation events, and hands-on learning about nature, astronomy, and science. At its Planetarium, one of the world's highest-level facilities, expert commentators give visitors live tours of the starry skies.

Japan Open-Air Folk House Museum

*Cashless payment for tickets is only available in the main building. The inner gate and the west gate accept cash only.



This open-air museum exhibits 25 relocated traditional houses representative of eastern Japan, built in the Edo period. Some of these relocated houses are listed as Important Cultural Properties. With various events including entertainment performance or kinds of lectures to be held throughout the year, you can enjoy changing sceneries in four seasons.

Pansies, Violas

There are pansies and violas beautifully blooming in yellow, purple, pink, and a variety of other colors. The Kodanaka District in Nakahara-ku is one of the leading areas in the prefecture where they are grown.



Pears

Kawasaki City became a major production area of pears in the Taisho period. Species such as the Chojuro Asian pear and Ikusui were created there and became well-liked as local specialties of Kawasaki City.



Persimmons

You can pick juicy persimmons in Kawasaki City, including Zenjimaruru persimmons which are said to have been first discovered in Ozenji over 800 years ago.



Blueberries

Because they have short bushes and berries that are easy to pick, blueberries are popular as fruit that are fun to pick together with small children.

Sweet potatoes

There are large farms in Kurokawa, Asao-ku, where food education is actively pursued with opportunities for first-hand experiences of digging up sweet potatoes and other activities.






