





This park is home to wild birds and beautiful flora, including sawtooth oaks and Japanese oaks. In this precious natural environment you can bask in the beauty of nature and appreciate the changing face of the forest throughout the year, from cherry blossoms in spring to the turning leaves in fall. The park is dotted with cultural facilities such as the Taro Okamoto Museum of Art, the Japan Open-air Folk House Museum and the Kawasaki Municipal Science Museum. 


Leisurely Sightseeing with Shared Bicycles 🚜 HELLO CYCLING CL

The eerie splendor of the cold, robotic light emitted by working machinery

When one could still gaze at the shallow sea off the shore, people of that time who came and went on the Tokaido road could not have imagined the current state of Kawasaki, the central city of the Keihin industrial area. There is a quiet pride in this area, which laid the foundations of Japan's economy with the plants built on 16 canals and 7 areas of reclaimed land all built throughout the ages starting from end of Meiji Era. We hope that visitors feel the thoughts of our predecessors even a little as they experience the extraordinary sights unique to the factory night scenery tour. The warm light emitted from the mechanical-like plants is sure to soothe the minds of those who see it.

In many factories along the coastal areas of Kawasaki, someone is working 24 hours a day, 365 days a year without a break. The night view of the factories consists of the lights that support such work. It is not a light display or brilliant illumination made to delight people. But just look at these lights! Just looking at them makes one excited. Go around to see this world of nighttime scenery, with petrochemical complexes and chemical plants of the Keihin trial area, shown in social studies textbooks, as the setting! Let's have an exciting time together!
