When one could still gaze at the shallow sea off the shore, people of that time who came and went on the Tokaido road could not have imagined the current state of Kawasaki, the central city of the Keihin industrial area. The warm light emitted from the mechanical-like plants is sure to soothe the minds of those who see it.

Enjoying the fresh and delicious crops you harvest with your own hands right at the farm and interacting with the people are sure to form special memories for you.

Off to the Tourist Farms!

Pansies, Violas

There are pansies and violas beautifully blooming in yellow, purple, pink, and a variety of other colors. The Kodanaka District in Nakahara-ku is one of the leading areas in the prefecture where they are grown.



Pears

Kawasaki City became a major production area of pears in the Taisho period. Species such as the Chojuro Asian pear and Ikusui were created there and became well-liked as local specialties of Kawasaki City.



Persimmons

You can pick juicy persimmons in Kawasaki City, including Zenjimaruru persimmons which are said to have been first discovered in Ozenji over 800 years ago.



Sweet potatoes

There are large farms in Kurokawa, Asao-ku, where food education is actively pursued with opportunities for first-hand experiences of digging up sweet potatoes and other activities.

Blueberries

Because they have short bushes and berries that are easy to pick, blueberries are popular as fruit that are fun to pick together with small children.

Mandarin oranges

Kanagawa Prefecture is famous as a production area for mandarin oranges, but actually you can also experience picking them in Kawasaki City as well!

Strawberry

Sweet strawberries can be picked from winter to spring. There are many tourist farms where you can eat and compare several different varieties.

Grapes

Grapes offer the taste of autumn. Kawasaki City grows such varieties as Kyoho and Fujimorino grapes which first appeared in Kanagawa Prefecture.

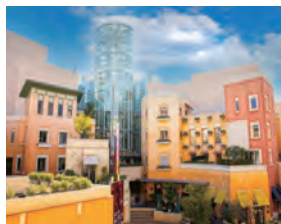

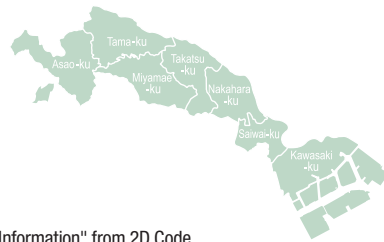

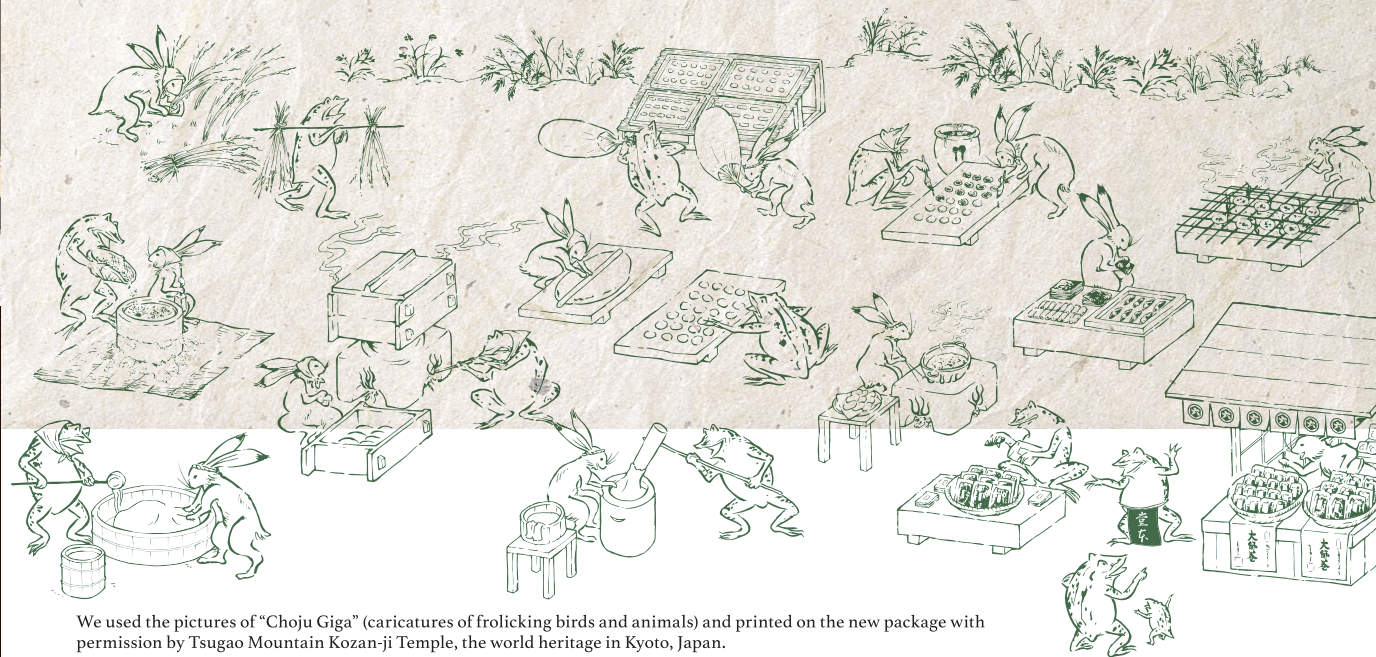
