

The eerie splendor of the cold, robotic light emitted by working machinery

Gazing at the nighttime factory view of Ukishima, one can't help but recall the words "I'll be back" intoned in the movie Terminator. The factory belt on the Kawasaki waterfront presents a nighttime factory view like some city of the future or a space station, as one might see in a sci-fi movie. Yet at the same time the night see in a scient novie. Tet a the same time the night time view of the plants is filled with nostalgia like a scene from an animated feature by Studio Ghibli Be sure to experience it at least once.

Unlike the illumination on downtown buildings, the lights of the Kawasaki nighttime factory view are not there to make the buildings look pretty. They provide the light necessary to enable the factories' night shifts to work safely. You may find yourself warming to the otherworldliness of the cold, robotic working lights.

The ward grows vegetables, fruit, and a wide variety of other crops throughout the year. People can experience harvesting blueberries and tomatoes in summer and strawberries and other crops in winter.




